14 WHEREAS, Mrs. Sokolyk was active in а number of organizations, including the Buck and Bull Club, the Kerr County 15 Extension Homemakers, the German Club, and the local Republican 16 Party; in addition, she was financial secretary for Hermann Sons 17 Lodge No. 12 for a number of years, and she also volunteered her 18 time as an election worker and as a thrift-shop employee for the 19 20 Humane Society; and

21 WHEREAS, After her husband passed away in 1989, Mrs. Sokolyk 22 took frequent trips abroad and visited relatives and schoolmates in 23 her home country; she moved to New Braunfels in 2006 to be closer to 24 her son and his family; and
