- 12 the Texas Education Agency for 9 of the past 13 years; its students
- 13 compete in the 1A classification in University Interscholastic
- 14 League academic and athletic contests; and

- 17 Granger ISD has provided generations of area Texans with a solid
- 18 foundation on which to build rewarding and productive lives; now,
