R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Granger Independent School District celebrated
2 the 125th anniversary of its creation in 2012; and

3 WHEREAS, A small town in Williamson County, Granger was
4 founded in 1882 and the Granger Common School District was
5 established in 1887; a school was constructed that same year and an
6 additional facility was built in 1906; the Hus Memorial School,
7 which opened in 1914, served as the site of a teacher enrichment
8 program; a new school was built in 1925, and it has since served as
9 the district's main building; it was designated a Recorded Texas
10 Historic Landmark in 1991; and

11 WHEREAS, Granger ISD has earned a "Recognized" rating from
12 the Texas Education Agency for 9 of the past 13 years; its students
13 compete in the 1A classification in University Interscholastic
14 League academic and athletic contests; and

15 WHEREAS, Grounded in the values of the families who have
16 chosen to make this small Williamson County community their home,
17 Granger ISD has provided generations of area Texans with a solid
18 foundation on which to build rewarding and productive lives; now,
19 therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
21 Legislature hereby commemorate the 125th anniversary of the Granger
22 Independent School District and extend to all faculty, staff, and
23 students sincere best wishes for continued success; and, be it
