1 WHEREAS, The University Breast Care Center of the Texas Tech
2 University Health Sciences Center at El Paso has received
3 accreditation through the National Accreditation Program for
4 Breast Centers; and

5 WHEREAS, The national accreditation program is a consortium
6 of professionals dedicated to improving breast cancer remedies and
7 outcomes; to be recognized, providers must furnish specific
8 elements of care and comply with rigid standards on leadership,
9 quality improvement, professional instruction, and scientific
10 analysis; and

11 WHEREAS, Founded in 1994 to provide comprehensive breast
12 disease therapy to medically indigent women in El Paso, the UBCC
13 also serves as a teaching environment for medical students,
14 coordinates community outreach and education, and conducts
15 research; and

16 WHEREAS, Nearly one-third of all new breast cancer diagnoses
17 in El Paso take place at the center, which is the only nationally
18 accredited breast care program in El Paso; and

19 WHEREAS, Staff of the University Breast Care Center are
20 fighting this devastating disease with vision, passion, and
21 tenacity, and their work is making a positive difference in the
22 lives of countless people; now, therefore, be it
