3 Hutson Littlefield of Midlothian on February 2, 2013, at the age of
4 35; and

5 WHEREAS, The son of Don and Judy Littlefield, Chad
6 Littlefield was born in Dallas on February 11, 1977, and was proud
7 to be a lifelong Texan; he graduated from DeSoto High School in 1995
8 and went on to pursue a career at Eagle Labs, where he worked as the
9 facilities and logistics manager; and

10 WHEREAS, A devoted husband and father, Mr. Littlefield took
11 great pleasure in family life; he was a source of strength and
12 support to his wife, Leanne, and his daughter, Morgan, as well as to
13 his many friends, who looked to him when in need of a kind or
14 comforting word; his desire to help others extended outside his
15 circle of loved ones, and he often assisted his friend Chris Kyle
16 with his nonprofit in behalf of veterans; and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Littlefield was sustained by a deep faith, and
18 his steadfast beliefs guided his actions; he was known as a man who
19 approached each day with optimism and good humor; and

20 WHEREAS, Although Chad Littlefield's life ended far too soon,
21 he leaves behind a legacy that will be forever treasured by all
22 those who were privileged to know him; now, therefore, be it
