6 WHEREAS, The victory in the title game of the state 7 tournament capped a remarkable season in which the Pantherettes 8 finished with a perfect record of 42-0 and claimed their second 9 consecutive state crown and the eighth in school history; the 10 team's winning streak now stands at an astounding 70 games; and

11 WHEREAS, Under the guidance of head coach Cathy Self-Morgan, 12 Duncanville powered through the postseason with commanding wins over Killeen, Hurst Bell, Cedar Hill, Arlington Bowie, and Coronado 13 14 High Schools to earn a trip to the state tournament; the team's margin of victory in its first five playoff games was never less 15 than 19 points and exceeded 30 points for three of the contests; and 16 WHEREAS, After topping League City Clear Springs in the 17 semifinals, the Pantherettes matched up against Cibolo Steele High 18 School for the championship; Duncanville led wire to wire and 19 20 secured a dominant 59-36 victory to hoist the trophy yet again; 21 senior Kiara Perry led the way with 20 points and 13 rebounds and was named the game's Most Valuable Player; she was joined on the 22 23 All-Tournament Team by junior Ariel Atkins, who contributed 13 points and 7 rebounds; and 24
