10 years and was a passionate supporter of the Aggies; in 2009, he
11 received the university's Distinguished Achievement Award; and

12 WHEREAS, A man of deep faith, Mr. Harrison joined Macedonia
13 Missionary Baptist Church at a young age and became the
14 congregation's pastor in 1999; in addition, he was an active member
15 of the Missionary Baptist Church Association; and

16 WHEREAS, This esteemed Texan shared a rewarding marriage with
17 his wife, Cheryl Ann Druery Felder Harrison; when she died in 1994,
18 Mr. Harrison was left to raise their three young sons, Frederick,
19 Corey, and Chauncey, on his own; and

20 WHEREAS, Fred Harrison lived a life that was centered around
21 his family and his faith, and those who were fortunate enough to
22 know him will forever remember him with great admiration and
