WHEREAS, Respected by his peers, Mr. Garrett has received numerous accolades, including the Top Rice Farming Operation in Texas award in 1992, selection as the National Rice Farmer of the Year in 1993, and the Lifetime Achievement Award in 2011; and

the Harvest Foundation, which works with area rice growers and 1 vendors to donate rice to local food banks; between 100 and 200 2 3 acres are dedicated to the project annually, translating into 8 to 10 million servings of rice for people in need; Mr. Garrett has also 4 5 shared his time and talents with the Back Pack Program, the Brazoria County Fair, and St. Anthony de Padua Catholic Church, where he is a 6 valued congregant and assistant teacher; moreover, he has been a 7 8 member of the board of the Danbury Independent School District for 12 years; and 9
