1           WHEREAS, Countless lives were touched by the kindness and  
2 generosity of Senior Corporal Olin Randall Heifner of Garland, who  
3 passed away on March 3, 2013, at the age of 66; and

4           WHEREAS, Born on December 24, 1946, in Dallas, Olin Heifner  
5 was the son of Sergeant Olin Arthur Heifner and Daisy Lucille  
6 Sigler; he enrolled in the ROTC program while attending Thomas  
7 Jefferson High School, and he later earned a bachelor's degree in  
8 business administration from The University of Texas at Arlington;

10           WHEREAS, After college, Mr. Heifner joined the United States  
11 Navy as a junior grade lieutenant, and when his service ended, he  
12 was honorably discharged as a full lieutenant and was awarded the  
13 National Defense Service Medal; and

14           WHEREAS, Mr. Heifner joined the Dallas Police Department in  
15 1974; over the course of his career, he rose through the ranks to  
16 become a detective and garnered numerous accolades, including  
17 awards for lifesaving, safety, and marksmanship; after more than 28  
18 years with the force, he retired with the rank of senior corporal;

20           WHEREAS, In all of his endeavors, Mr. Heifner enjoyed the  
21 support of his wife, Mary Elizabeth, with whom he shared nearly  
22 three decades; over the years, their family grew to include a  
23 daughter, Saranne, and her husband, Rick; and

24           WHEREAS, Olin Heifner was deeply devoted to his family, his

1 country, and his community, and he will forever be remembered with  
2 admiration and affection; now, therefore, be it

3         RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas  
4 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Senior Corporal  
5 Olin Randall Heifner and extend sincere sympathy to the members of  
6 his family: to his wife, Mary Elizabeth Heifner; to his daughter,  
7 Saranne Corley Ricco, and her husband, Rick; to his sister, Barbara  
8 Jan Heifner, and her husband, Bill Harris; to his nephews, Bob and  
9 Ted Eikenberry; to his cherished friends, Dennis and Sue Williams;
