- 1 WHEREAS, The safety and well-being of the children of Texas
- 2 are of concern to all our citizens, but an estimated 50,000 youths
- 3 are reported missing each year in this state; and
- WHEREAS, Since 1983, May 25th has been recognized as National
- 5 Missing Children's Day, and this occasion affords an opportunity to
- 6 make child protection a countrywide priority; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Through the Take 25 Campaign, the National Center
- 8 for Missing and Exploited Children and its Texas regional office
- 9 provide resources to help families learn about and prevent
- 10 abductions; since 1990, the percentage of domestically missing
- 11 children who have been found has increased from 62 percent to 96
- 12 percent; and
- WHEREAS, Participation in this cause by local governments,
- 14 law enforcement, schools, community-based organizations, and
- 15 families will lead to increased awareness of appropriate protective
- 16 measures and result in safer communities; and
- 17 WHEREAS, National Missing Children's Day is a time to
- 18 remember those who have been taken, offer hope to their loved ones,
- 19 and educate the public about a matter of serious concern; now,
- 20 therefore, be it
- 21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
- 22 Legislature hereby recognize May 25, 2013, as National Missing
- 23 Children's Day and encourage all Texans to learn more about this
- 24 heartbreaking issue.
