9 proudest accomplishments her success in lowering the recidivism

rate of adults with substance abuse problems by requiring them to

11 check in with authorities at regular intervals and by monitoring

12 them with ankle bracelets and other tools; and

WHEREAS, Judge Weiser has additionally devoted her abilities

14 to ensuring that young persons receive proper treatment and avoid

15 the "revolving door" of the justice system; to that end, she

16 advocated for and oversaw the construction of the first juvenile

17 detention facility in Victoria, where she presided over cases for

18 many years; moreover, she collaborated with Victoria ISD officials

19 and members of the district attorney's office to plan and

20 coordinate an effective system for dealing with truant students;

- 3 for Judicial Studies, and the National Judicial College; and

- 5 Ms. Weiser worked for two local law firms before becoming a staff
- 6 attorney with Coastal Bend Legal Services, a position that involved
- 7 providing counsel to indigent clients; she subsequently joined the
- 8 criminal district attorney's office and represented the Texas
- 9 Department of Family and Protective Services in prosecuting
- 10 interstate child support cases and juvenile delinquency
- 11 proceedings; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Judge Weiser has shared her knowledge and expertise
- 13 with her peers in a multitude of professional organizations; in
- 14 addition to spending a decade as a faculty member and advisor for
- 15 the College for New Judges, she served for several years as chair of
- 16 the Texas Center for the Judiciary and as elected chair of the
- 17 judicial section of the state bar; in 2011, she was appointed by
- 18 Wallace B. Jefferson, chief justice of the Supreme Court of Texas,
- 19 to the Texas Judicial Council, a policy-making body composed of
- 20 judges, lawmakers, and citizen leaders; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Through the years, Ms. Weiser has benefited from the
- 22 love and support of her husband, Juan Velasquez III, who is retired
- 23 as the judge of Victoria County Court at Law No. 2, and she takes
- 24 great pride in her children, Jessica and Scott; and

- 26 fairness, foresight, and professionalism, and she can take great
