R E S O L U T I O N

2 rank of Eagle Scout, and this accomplishment truly merits special  
3 recognition; and

4           WHEREAS, Receiving the Eagle Scout badge is a significant  
5 honor, bestowed on only a small fraction of those who enter the  
6 scouting movement; in the course of meeting the rank's demanding  
7 criteria, "Cray" Steger earned 31 merit badges, and for his Eagle  
8 Scout project, he constructed a storage shed for the Humane Society  
9 of Williamson County; and

17 completed the Capitol Area Council's National Youth Leadership

20           WHEREAS, In addition to his scouting activities, Mr. Steger  
21 is a freshman at East View High School and attends Palm Valley  
22 Lutheran Church; and

23           WHEREAS, Eagle Scout Steger's dedication to excellence and  
24 his perseverance in the pursuit of his goals have proven him worthy

1 to stand among scouting's elite, and he may indeed reflect with  
2 pride on a job well done; now, therefore, be it

3       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas  
4 Legislature hereby congratulate Curtis Ray Steger II on achieving  
5 the rank of Eagle Scout and extend to him sincere best wishes for  
6 continued success and happiness; and, be it further
