## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Chad Bowden was born in Pasadena on July 20, 1982, to Charles and Gwendolyn Bowden; after graduating from Furr High School, he went on to earn a bachelor's degree from Prairie View A&M University, where he was twice named to the dean's list, and a master's degree in education with a certification in mid-management from Lamar University; and

WHEREAS, While working at a printing company for a law firm, 10 Mr. Bowden explained a problem so well to a colleague that he was 11 12 asked if he had ever considered teaching; this event inspired him to pursue a career in education, which began in the Houston 13 14 Independent School District with two years at Francis Scott Key Middle School; he then became a physical education teacher at 15 16 Pleasantville Elementary, where many students affectionately referred to him as "Coach B"; and 17

18 WHEREAS, A devout Christian from an early age, Mr. Bowden 19 sang in the youth choir and served on the usher board at Lane 20 Tabernacle CME Church; he later joined Christian Tabernacle and 21 served as a teacher of the church's open Bible study; and

22 WHEREAS, Mr. Bowden benefited his community as a volunteer at 23 the Methodist Hospital as well as at numerous church and school 24 events; in addition, he conducted basketball camps and served as a
