1 WHEREAS, Dr. Wright Lassiter, Jr., has announced plans to 2 retire as chancellor of the Dallas County Community College District, drawing to a close a tenure marked by considerable 3 progress and achievement; and 4 5 WHEREAS, The sixth chancellor to lead the district, Dr. Lassiter has presided over one of the largest community college 6 systems in the state; since taking office in 2006, he has overseen a 7 20 percent increase in student enrollment and the completion of a 8 \$450 million bond program, which added five new campuses in 9 fast-growing or underserved areas of Dallas County; the program has 10 11 additionally funded the construction of 12 state-of-the-art facilities throughout the district's seven colleges, including several that have been recognized with 13 14 architectural design and sustainability awards; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Lassiter studied business administration at 15 Indiana University, 16 Alcorn State University and and master's degrees from those respective 17 undergraduate institutions, and he holds a doctorate in education from Auburn 18 University; his extensive experience in university administration 19 includes a 20-year tenure as president of El Centro College, a 20 21 component of the DCCCD, and terms as president of Bishop College in 22 Dallas and Schenectady County Community College in New York; he has 23 additionally held posts managing business and financial matters at 24 Morgan State University in Maryland and at Tuskegee University in

WHEREAS, Along with his professional endeavors, Dr. Lassiter 2 3 has benefited the community through his work with many civic organizations; he has chaired the boards of both the Urban League of 4 Greater Dallas and North Central Texas and the African American 5 Museum, and he has served on the boards of Southwestern Medical 6 Foundation, the United Way of Metropolitan Dallas, the YMCA 7 8 Foundation, and the State Fair of Texas; he has also held a seat on the advisory boards at Baylor University and Auburn University, and 9 10 in 2002 he was appointed by President George W. Bush to the National Advisory Council of the National Endowment for the Humanities; and 11 WHEREAS, This distinguished educator has received numerous 12 accolades over the course of his career, among them the 2010 Russell 13 14 H. Perry Free Enterprise Award from Dallas Baptist University, a 15 prize that recognizes achievements in business and civic service; moreover, he has been elected to the Indiana University Academy of 16 17 Alumni Fellows, and he was recently inducted into the African American Educators Hall of Fame in Dallas; and 18 WHEREAS, Dr. Lassiter's adept and forward-looking leadership 19 has helped to guide the Dallas County Community College District 20 21 through a transformative period in its history, and his many 22 valuable contributions will continue to garner appreciation in the 23 years to come; now, therefore, be it 24 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas 25 Legislature hereby congratulate Dr. Wright Lassiter, Jr., on his 26 forthcoming retirement as chancellor of the Dallas County Community
