1 WHEREAS, Dr. Lovell Jones of Houston has greatly contributed
2 to the field of medicine through his work to improve health care for
3 minorities and the medically underserved; and

4 WHEREAS, Affiliated with The University of Texas MD Anderson
5 Cancer Center for more than three decades, Dr. Jones currently
6 serves as director of the Dorothy I. Height Center for Health
7 Equity and Evaluation Research, a program dedicated to addressing
8 medical inequalities through a holistic approach; he has further
9 contributed to this vital mission as chair of the Health
10 Disparities Education, Awareness, Research & Training Consortium,
11 as founding co-chair of the Intercultural Cancer Council, and as
12 editor of *Minorities & Cancer*, one of the few comprehensive
13 textbooks on the subject; and

14 WHEREAS, This notable Texan is also the founding chair of
15 *Minorities, the Medically Underserved and Cancer*, a multicultural
16 biennial conference to promote the exchange of the latest
17 scientific and treatment information; and

18 WHEREAS, Dr. Lovell A. Jones has been a tireless health care
19 advocate for those in this country who have borne the burden of
20 disease disproportionately, and it is a privilege to recognize his
21 insightful and inspiring leadership in addressing an issue of
22 immeasurable import for all Americans; now, therefore, be it
