1           WHEREAS, The Georgetown Fire Department held a dedication  
2 ceremony and open house for the new Fire Station No. 2 on March 16,  
3 2013; and

4           WHEREAS, Built at a cost of \$1.7 million, Fire Station No. 2  
5 will serve central Georgetown; and

6           WHEREAS, With two fire engines and a hazardous materials  
7 response vehicle housed there, the facility provides coverage for  
8 downtown Georgetown and much of the central part of the city; and

9           WHEREAS, A credit to the planning and foresight of fire chief  
10 John Sullivan and other city officials, Georgetown's new fire  
11 station is a vital and reassuring presence in the community; now,  
12 therefore, be it

13           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas  
14 Legislature hereby commemorate the dedication of the new Fire  
15 Station No. 2 in Georgetown and commend all those who contributed to  
16 its creation for a job well done; and, be it further

17           RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
18 prepared for the station as an expression of high regard by the  
19 Texas House of Representatives.
