## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Members of the Sour Lake community are mourning the 2 loss of one of their own with the passing of former mayor and longtime barber David Payne on March 17, 2013, at the age of 68; and 3 WHEREAS, Born on October 11, 1944, in Saratoga to Helen 4 5 Lorraine Brackin Payne and Alfred Taylor Payne, David Payne began cutting hair in 1964 at a small barbershop in downtown Sour Lake; 6 the shop had been in business since the year he was born and was 7 known among residents as the first place in Sour Lake to have 8 air-conditioning; Mr. Payne became its sole owner in 1970; and 9

10 WHEREAS, Payne's Barbershop was a popular meeting place, 11 where any number of people could be found holding forth on all 12 manner of subjects; Mr. Payne himself acknowledged his key role in 13 Sour Lake with the wry comment "a good barber is a psychologist, a 14 psychiatrist, a marriage counselor, and a bartender," and evidence 15 of the high regard in which he was held was provided when he was 16 elected mayor in 1981 as a write-in candidate; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Payne further contributed to his fellow citizens as acting chief of the town's volunteer fire department, as president of the Lions Club, and as a Mason; and

20 WHEREAS, In all of his endeavors, this esteemed Texan enjoyed 21 the love and support of his wife, Karen, and his children, Michael 22 and Kasie, and he was the proud grandfather of four; and

23 WHEREAS, Though he joked that he took up his trade because he 24 was "too lazy to work and too cautious for a life of crime," David
