1 WHEREAS, Family, friends, and members of Mt. Corinth
2 Missionary Baptist Church in Hempstead are mourning the loss of
3 Pastor Lloyd Crosby, who passed away on April 3, 2013; and

4 WHEREAS, A graduate of Phillis Wheatley High School, Lloyd
5 Crosby earned his bachelor's degree from Bishop College and his
6 master's degree from Colgate Rochester Crozer Divinity School; and

7 WHEREAS, Pastor Crosby was called to the ministry in 1970;
8 his career included a notable tenure with Mt. Corinth Missionary
9 Baptist Church, where his faith and guidance were an inspiration to
10 many; and

11 WHEREAS, In addition to his work with his congregation,
12 Pastor Crosby served as a chaplain with the Hempstead Police
13 Department, directed the Seventh Street Community Development
14 Corporation, and hosted *Teen Talk* on KPVU 91.3; he further shared
15 his time and expertise with the executive committee for the Prairie
16 View A&M University Ministers Conference and with the National
17 Baptist Congress of Christian Education, Texas State Missionary
18 Baptist Convention, and Houston Ministers Against Crime; and

19 WHEREAS, This esteemed clergyman was supported in all of his
20 endeavors by his wife, Karyn Crosby, and he took great pride in his
21 daughter, Lynnetia; and

22 WHEREAS, Pastor Lloyd Crosby lived a caring and purposeful
23 life, and though his death has brought great sorrow to all who knew
24 him, he leaves behind a legacy of good works that will long resonate
