R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The Munday High School football team capped an  
2 undefeated season by winning the 2012 University Interscholastic  
3 League 1A Division 2 state championship on December 20 at Cowboys  
4 Stadium in Arlington; and

5           WHEREAS, This occasion marked the second consecutive year  
6 that the Moguls reached the title game, and once again they faced  
7 the team from Tenaha High School; eager to avenge its loss in the  
8 2011 championship final, Munday jumped out to an early lead only to  
9 have Tenaha battle back to tie the score 14-14 at the half; and

10           WHEREAS, The turning point in the game came with just less  
11 than five minutes to play in the third quarter; Munday defensive end  
12 L. J. Collier returned an interception 37 yards for a touchdown to  
13 give the Moguls a 28-14 lead; quarterback Dee Paul then reeled off  
14 two long touchdown runs in the fourth quarter to pad the lead while  
15 the tough Munday defense completely shut down the Tenaha scoring  
16 attack throughout the second half; when the final seconds ticked  
17 away, the Moguls claimed a decisive 42-14 triumph and the third  
18 football championship in school history; and

19           WHEREAS, All season long, Munday excelled thanks to a true  
20 team effort, with impressive leadership provided by senior captains  
21 Jake Myers, Tyrone Dockins, Logan Groves, and Dee Paul; the squad  
22 received expert guidance from head coach Patrick Corcoran and  
23 assistant coaches Ronny Lowrance, Greg Clark, and Larry Welch;  
24 valuable support was also provided by superintendent Robert

1 Dillard, principal Tra Hall, and a dedicated staff of student  
2 trainers; and

3 WHEREAS, The members of the Munday High football team  
4 demonstrated admirable skill and determination in winning the state  
5 championship and attaining a flawless record against top  
6 competition, and they will forever treasure the memory of this  
7 unforgettable season; now, therefore, be it
