## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Roy May, Jr., an army combat veteran who has 2 demonstrated bravery and diligence in service to his nation, has 3 returned home to continue a cherished family custom by attending 4 Texas A&M University; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. May was born in Bryan in 1979 to Roy and Becky 6 May; three years after graduating from Klein High School in Spring, 7 he enlisted in the U.S. Army, continuing a strong military 8 tradition begun by his grandfather during World War II, carried on 9 by his father, who saw action in Vietnam, and also embraced by his 10 sister Amanda, a West Point graduate; and

11 WHEREAS, Assigned to the 3rd U.S. Army Infantry Regiment, Mr. 12 May was soon dispatched to the Pentagon as part of the rescue and 13 recovery efforts taking place after the terrorist attacks of 14 September 11, 2001; he later served as a guard at the Tomb of the 15 Unknown Soldier and was chosen as the noncommissioned officer in 16 charge when former president Ronald Reagan lay in state in the 17 Capitol Rotunda; and

18 WHEREAS, After completing the U.S. Army Pathfinder School, he 19 was assigned to the 82nd Airborne Division and was deployed to Iraq, 20 where he served as a squad leader in support of Operation Iraqi 21 Freedom; and

WHEREAS, During the course of his distinguished service, Mr. May received the Army Commendation Medal, Army Achievement Medal, Army Superior Unit Award, and Army Good Conduct Medal, as well as

the National Defense Service Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service
Medal, and Iraq Campaign Medal with campaign star; and

10 WHEREAS, In all that he has undertaken, Mr. May has enjoyed 11 the love and support of his wife, Megan, who is also an army 12 veteran; the couple are the proud and devoted parents of a daughter, 13 Kira Celene; and

WHEREAS, Through his courage, professionalism, and dedication to duty, Roy May, Jr., embodies the highest values of the United States armed forces, and it is a privilege to honor him for his selfless efforts in this country's behalf; now, therefore, be it
