- 8 Odessa High School in 1954 and subsequently earned a degree from the

- 14 Bank in Odessa, and finally at the First National Bank of Fort

- 16 chair of both NCNB Texas Fort Worth and of the Texas Region of NCNB;

- 19 greatly to his community as well and was active in numerous civic
- 20 organizations, including the United Way of Tarrant County, which he
- 21 served as president and as chair of the board of trustees; he also

- 23 served as a treasurer of the Fort Worth Corporation, and served as
- 24 vice president of the Fort Worth Chamber of Commerce; he further

- 3 Perry held a seat on the board of directors of the Colorado River
- 4 Municipal Water District and served as a trustee of the Harris
- 5 Methodist Health System, as governor and treasurer of the Fort
- 6 Worth Club, and as an executive committee member of the Southwest
- 7 Exposition and Livestock Show; and
- 8 WHEREAS, In all of his endeavors, Mr. Perry enjoyed the love
- 9 and support of his wife, June, and he was the proud father of two
- 10 sons, Jeffrey and Joel; he had the pleasure of welcoming into his
- 11 family a daughter-in-law, Denise, and four grandchildren, Jordan,

- 14 will long be remembered with deep affection by those who were
