1 WHEREAS, A full and productive life drew to a close with the
2 passing of Clyde R. Butter, Sr., of Odessa on February 24, 2013, at
3 the age of 82; and

4 WHEREAS, Born in Sheldon on September 20, 1930, Mr. Butter
5 was the son of Robert and Ethel Butter; he attended the University
6 of Houston, and a brief position at a local radio station sparked
7 his desire to work in the media; after serving his country in the
8 United States Navy during the Korean War, he embarked on a
9 distinguished career in broadcasting; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Butter became a radio, television, and stage
11 personality, and he launched an innovative service, Capital
12 Broadcast News, in the state capital; his passion for politics led
13 him to run for the state house of representatives, and he was later
14 elected to the office of reading clerk for the house; he went on to
15 interview many elected officials as the owner of radio station KRIL
16 in Odessa, and his stories aired nationally on such CBS news
17 programs as *60 Minutes*; moreover, he wrote four books, among them a
18 professional autobiography entitled *Theater of the Mind: Three*
19 *Quarters of a Century of Radio Across Texas*; and

20 WHEREAS, Through the years, Mr. Butter maintained his
21 interest in activities he shared with his father as a boy, including
22 building, working with his hands, and spending time outdoors, and
23 he carried on his mother's appreciation for classical literature
24 and the arts; he was devoted to his family and to his cherished

1 pets, and he was a valued member of the Lutheran Church of the Risen
2 Lord; and

3 WHEREAS, Although Clyde Butter will be deeply missed, he will
4 always be remembered with great admiration and affection by those
5 who were privileged to share in the richness of his life; now,
6 therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
8 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Clyde R. Butter,
9 Sr., and extend sincere sympathy to the members of his family: to
10 his wife, Charlene Butter; to his sons, Dr. Donovan Butter and his
11 fiancée, Rita Bell, Michael Butter, Clyde R. Butter, Jr., and his
12 wife, Susie, and Michael Cameron and his wife, Amber; to his
13 grandchildren, Matthew, Haley, Valerie, Andrea, and Natalie
14 Butter, Chris Holman, and Lillian Beatrice Cameron; to his
15 great-grandchildren, Andrew, Aaron, and Ava Butter, Hallie, Jacob,
16 and Caleb Bates, Christopher and Riley Holman, and Lily Huth; to his
17 brothers, Donovan Butter and his wife, Sylvia, and James Robert
18 "Bob" Butter and his wife, Carol Ann; and to his many other
