WHEREAS, Founded in 1957 by the well-known actor Billy Barty, the LPA is the only organization that supports people with any of the more than 200 forms of dwarfism; the LPA assists members and their families with such issues as parenting and adoption and provides medical resources and referrals and information about educational scholarships; moreover, the LPA is involved in a range of community outreach initiatives; and
