4           WHEREAS, Joe Phillips was born in Houston on September 8,  
5 1936, to Otto and Aline Phillips; answering his nation's call to  
6 duty, he served in the U.S. Marine Corps; and

8 Houston Fire Department, working in a variety of posts, including  
9 public information officer, before retiring in 2011 with 48 years

11 Reagan Masonic Lodge No. 1037, American Legion Post No. 560, and  
12 the Scottish Rite; and

13           WHEREAS, Friendly and outgoing, Mr. Phillips could often be  
14 found sitting in his carport, where he engaged every person who  
15 passed by with a joke or a story; he was known for his interest in  
16 history and was especially knowledgeable about his hometown;  
17 moreover, he was a skilled woodworker, and he had a knack for  
18 repairing engines; in recent years, he took great pleasure in  
19 riding his Harley Davidson motorcycle; and

20           WHEREAS, Mr. Phillips shared 53 years of marriage with his  
21 wife, Patricia Lindsay Phillips, and the couple were blessed with  
22 three children, Cynthia, Michael, and Stacey; and

23           WHEREAS, A proud Marine, firefighter, and native Houstonian,  
24 Joe Phillips lived a rich and purposeful life centered around his

1 family and friends, and he will long be remembered with deep  
2 affection by all those who were privileged to know him; now,  
3 therefore, be it

4         RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas  
5 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Joseph Allison
