R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Through her longtime involvement in grassroots
2 politics, Linda Kinney has made an invaluable contribution to the
3 vitality of civic life in Hays County; and

4 WHEREAS, This dynamic Texan has served the Hays County
5 Republican Executive Committee in a number of roles, including
6 those of precinct chair, county chair, secretary, and treasurer,
7 and she has worked tirelessly to elect numerous successful
8 candidates in Hays County to such offices as sheriff, county
9 commissioner, and county judge; moreover, for the past 15 years,
10 she has assisted in organizing the party's annual Lincoln-Reagan
11 dinner events; and

12 WHEREAS, In 2012, Ms. Kinney was elected as the State
13 Republican Executive Committeewoman for Senate District 25, which
14 includes Hays, Guadalupe, Comal, Bexar, Kendall, and Travis

22 commissioner; and

24 encouragement of her husband, Wally Kinney, as well as their two
