1 WHEREAS, Members of the Rotary Club of Arlington are 2 celebrating their club's 90th anniversary on June 13, 2013, and

3 this occasion offers a welcome opportunity to honor the

4 organization and its many charitable endeavors; and

WHEREAS, Founded in 1923, the Rotary Club of Arlington was the first service group to be established in the city, and over the years, the organization has benefited from the talented leadership of many prominent individuals, including past club president and

9 former mayor Tom Vandergriff; and

WHEREAS, From the beginning, the club has contributed to the 10 11 betterment of its community; one of its initial projects was 12 sponsorship of Arlington's first public park, Meadowbrook, which opened in 1924, and it later also contributed to the development of 13 14 Senter Park; today, the club offers adult literacy programs to Arlington residents and works with John Webb Elementary School, 15 where more than 94 percent of the students live at or below the 16 poverty level; most notably, the club provides college assistance 17 to every child graduating from Webb Elementary if that student also 18 graduates from high school; through this program, some 150 Webb 19 students have gone on to postsecondary education, reflecting a 20 21 college attendance rate 55 percent higher than the national rate for a matching demographic; the group also provides books to the 22 23 Webb Elementary library as well as to each student, funds camping trips for every sixth grader, and organizes cleanup days for the 24

- 1 grounds; in recognition of its outstanding work, the organization
- 2 received the 2012 Champions of Change Award from the White House,
- 3 making it one of only 10 Rotary Clubs nationwide to be granted this
- 4 honor; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The club is additionally engaged in service projects
- 6 in other countries; it has initiated a program to supply clean
- 7 drinking water to remote villages in Honduras, and it supports
- 8 Rotary International in its efforts to help eradicate polio around
- 9 the world; and
- 10 WHEREAS, For nine decades, members of the Rotary Club of
- 11 Arlington have epitomized the ideal of service that stands at the
- 12 heart of the Rotary mission, and they have enriched the lives of
- 13 countless individuals both at home and abroad; now, therefore, be
