2 State University Athletic Hall of Fame on June 1, 2013, the second
3 time that she has received that prestigious honor; and

4 WHEREAS, Enshrined as an individual athlete in 2002, Ms.
5 Curtis is now entering the hall as a member of the 1991-1992 TexAnns
6 basketball team that reached the National Association of
7 Intercollegiate Athletics Division II championship game; she was
8 named a first-team All-American for her exceptional play that
9 season, and she established several TSU records during her years at
10 the university that still stand today; and

11 WHEREAS, Ms. Curtis now serves as the head coach of the girls'
12 track team and as an assistant coach for the girls' basketball team
13 at her alma mater, Georgetown High School, where she was a star
14 basketball player before her collegiate career; and

16 1991-1992 TexAnns, Kristin Curtis was instrumental in helping TSU
17 women's basketball to attain greater national prominence, and it is
18 indeed fitting that she and her teammates be recognized for their
19 notable accomplishments; now, therefore, be it

21 Legislature hereby congratulate Kristin Curtis on her induction
