20 has additionally served as a member of the Knights of Columbus, and
21 in his role as a mentor for students, he has sought to provide
22 encouragement and guidance while fostering leadership skills; in
23 recognition of his civic engagement, he was presented with the
24 university's Horizon Award in 2011; and

2 handled the duties of their respective offices with the utmost
3 dedication and ability, and their contributions have earned them
4 the enduring respect and admiration of their friends and colleagues
5 at the university; now, therefore, be it
