2 anniversary of its founding in 2012; and

3 WHEREAS, Established by 39 charter members, the Newton Garden
4 Club was led by president Helen Syler when it held its inaugural
5 meeting at First United Methodist Church in September 1962; today,
6 the organization continues to affirm the original purpose laid out
7 in the bylaws to "stimulate the love of gardening, encourage home
8 and community beautification, promote better horticultural
9 practices, and to encourage all forms of conservation"; and

10 WHEREAS, Each year, the garden club hosts a flower show where
11 area residents enjoy showcasing their projects; members have worked
12 to beautify the city by planting and maintaining gardens at the
13 county courthouse and at the Powell Hotel Museum, where they placed
14 a plaque to honor those who have served in our nation's military; in
15 addition, the group has planted more than 2,000 daffodils, which
16 bring vibrant color to the community each year; and

17 WHEREAS, For half a century, the Newton Garden Club has
18 provided its members an opportunity to set aside their daily cares
19 and enjoy the happiness found in creating a thing of beauty, and
20 through their efforts, they have brightened the lives of their
21 fellow residents; now, therefore, be it
