

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The City of Dallas Sanitation Department's Waste  
2 Diversion Team is hosting the Dallas Spring Recycling Round-up on  
3 April 27, 2013; and

4           WHEREAS, The Waste Diversion Team was created to educate  
5 residents about waste reduction, increase the ease of recycling,  
6 and minimize the overall environmental impact of the Dallas  
7 community; and

8           WHEREAS, In an effort to prevent reusable items from  
9 unnecessarily entering landfills, the team has organized a citywide  
10 recycling collection on April 27; in what promises to be one of the  
11 largest drives of its kind in North Texas, residents are encouraged  
12 to bring scrap materials such as paper and packaging, along with  
13 more difficult-to-recycle objects like appliances, electronics,  
14 pharmaceuticals, clothing, and toys; and

15           WHEREAS, Sustaining the ecological well-being of our  
16 communities requires responsibility and commitment, and  
17 participants in the Dallas event can take pride in knowing that they  
18 are helping to create a cleaner and healthier environment for all to  
19 enjoy; now, therefore, be it

20           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas  
21 Legislature hereby recognize the valuable efforts of the Waste  
22 Diversion Team in implementing the Dallas Spring Recycling Round-up  
23 and encourage citizens to do their part to conserve natural  
24 resources by participating in this and other such initiatives.
