R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Sun City Hunting and Fishing Club donated \$5,500
2 raised through its annual silent auction to five deserving local
3 organizations; and

4 WHEREAS, A group that encourages outdoor sporting activities
5 among individuals of all skill levels, the Sun City Hunting and
6 Fishing Club also plays a positive role in the community through its
7 charitable efforts; and

8 WHEREAS, Proceeds from the club's 2012 fund-raiser are
9 benefiting the Texas Brigades organization, which involves youth in
10 conservation initiatives, Honor Flight, which assists veterans in
11 visiting the World War II National Memorial in Washington, D.C.,
12 the Ride On Center for Kids, which provides equine therapy for
13 children and adults with physical and cognitive challenges, the Boy
14 Scouts Capitol Area Council, and the Girl Scouts of the United
15 States; and

16 WHEREAS, The silent auction is held in conjunction with the
17 club's popular fish fry and also helps finance several other
18 endeavors, including the Georgetown Junior University Project,
19 which teaches children how to fish, and cooperative work with the
20 U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to improve the fishing habitat of Lake
21 Georgetown; moreover, the club sponsors Wounded Warrior
22 Appreciation events and stocks the Berry Creek Pond with fish, and
23 it is contributing to the creation of a new two-acre lake in Sun
24 City; and

1 WHEREAS, By supporting a range of worthwhile causes, the Sun
2 City Hunting and Fishing Club is enriching the civic life of Central
3 Texas, and its members are to be commended for their commitment and
4 generosity; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
6 Legislature hereby honor the Sun City Hunting and Fishing Club for
7 its contributions to the community and extend to its members
8 sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further
