1 WHEREAS, Dedicated volunteers helped to preserve the natural
2 splendor of Lake Ray Roberts on March 16, 2013, during the 6th
3 Annual Waterway Cleanup hosted by Keep Pilot Point Beautiful; and

5 Waterways Clean program, the event offered an opportunity for
6 residents to donate their time in behalf of Lake Ray Roberts, a
