- WHEREAS, Born on November 3, 1985, Angel Garcia was the son of

- 6 companionship of his brother and sister, Miguel and Allyson; he
- 7 earned his diploma from Clint High School in 2004 and went on to
- 8 serve his country in the U.S. Marine Corps; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Following his military service, Mr. Garcia began
- 10 pursuing his lifelong dream of becoming a police officer; he
- 11 excelled in his training at the police academy, where he was singled
- 12 out for his leadership skills and made commander of his class;
- 13 shortly after graduating in March 2012, he was sworn in as an
- 14 officer of the El Paso Police Department; and
- WHEREAS, Officer Garcia's career in law enforcement was brief
- 16 but distinguished; possessing a strong work ethic, he was often one
- 17 of the first to begin his shift in the early morning hours; he was
- 18 noted for his expertise on the tenets of military protocol, which
- 19 the Police Department follows, and enjoyed widespread respect among
- 20 colleagues of every rank; and
- 21 WHEREAS, This caring Texan embraced opportunities to serve
- 22 others in need, even forgoing a day off to take a group of
- 23 underprivileged children on a shopping trip during the annual Cops
- 24 Helping Kids event; regardless of the challenges and

- 1 responsibilities laid before him, his enthusiasm for his work
- 2 showed at every turn, and his cheerful attitude and lively sense of
- 3 humor were a source of enjoyment throughout the department; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Although Officer Garcia's tragic death has brought
- 5 an untimely end to a life so filled with promise, the memory of his
- 6 generosity and devotion to duty will forever endure in the hearts of
- 7 his family and friends, his brothers and sisters on the force, and
- 8 all others who were fortunate enough to know him; now, therefore, be
