WHEREAS, Following his retirement, Mr. Cagle moved to the Rosanky area, where he raised longhorn cattle for a while and enjoyed deer hunting; his other favorite pastimes included building model rockets and computers, working on projects around the house, and spending time with friends and family, sharing laughs and reflections on life; and
