RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, National Safe Boating Week is being observed from
- 2 May 18 to 24, 2013; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Recreational boating, including fishing and
- 4 waterskiing, is an immensely popular summer sport among Texans, and
- 5 waterways can quickly become crowded, resulting in confusion,
- 6 unforeseen risks, and, too often, tragedy; and
- 7 WHEREAS, According to the National Safe Boating Council, 700
- 8 people die each year in boating-related accidents in the United
- 9 States, and approximately 70 percent of these fatalities are caused
- 10 by drowning; the vast majority of accidents occur because of human
- 11 error or poor judgment and can be easily prevented; recreational
- 12 boaters should never operate a boat while under the influence of
- 13 alcohol or drugs; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Statistics have shown that about 80 percent of those
- 15 who drowned in boating mishaps were not wearing a life jacket;
- 16 although many boaters stow life jackets on board, there is rarely
- 17 enough time to properly employ one in the event of an accident; in
- 18 an effort to increase people's willingness to wear this essential
- 19 piece of safety equipment, modern life jackets have been designed
- 20 to be smaller, lighter, and more comfortable; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Boating accidents happen regardless of one's level
- 22 of experience, and wearing a life jacket is the most effective way
- 23 to prevent drowning for veteran and novice boaters alike; now,
- 24 therefore, be it
