R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The Brock High School girls' basketball team added  
2 to its tradition of excellence on the hardwood by winning its fifth  
3 consecutive University Interscholastic League 2A state  
4 championship on March 2, 2013, at the Frank Erwin Center in Austin;

6           WHEREAS, Finishing with an outstanding record of 35 wins and  
7 just 5 losses, including a perfect 12-0 mark in district play, the  
8 Lady Eagles made a thrilling run through the postseason that  
9 included victories over Sunnyvale, Howe, Alba-Golden, and Alvord  
10 High Schools to reach the state tournament; after a resounding  
11 triumph in the semifinals against Centerville, Brock defeated  
12 Merkel in the title contest by a score of 40-32 to claim the eighth  
13 state crown in school history; and

14           WHEREAS, Braylee Flaska scored 16 points in the tournament  
15 final to earn Most Valuable Player honors, and she was joined on the  
16 All-Tournament team by Cora Jenkins; the Lady Eagles also received  
17 significant contributions throughout the season from the other  
18 members of the roster: Rachel Harrell, Kylie Ducat, Sierra  
19 Bradshaw, Taylor Wallace, Cydnie Bynum, Bailey Ivey, Rachel  
20 Williams, Trisha Jacobs, Allie Popeck, Taylor Fulmer, and Lexie  
21 Ducat; and

22           WHEREAS, The team was guided by head coach Chance  
23 Westmoreland and assistant coaches Jason Morales and Chrissy  
24 Worrell; additional support was provided by managers Shileigh Potts

1 and Ashley Brawner, statisticians Madi Mayfield and Breana Madry,  
2 water girl Taylor Ducat, principal Jamie Payne, athletic director  
3 Scott Drillette, and superintendent Richard Tedder; and

5 girls' 2A basketball squad in the Lone Star State, the Brock Lady  
6 Eagles have demonstrated exceptional teamwork and dedication, and  
7 their achievement is a source of tremendous pride to their school
