R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The South Plains Wildlife Rehabilitation Center is
2 marking its 25th anniversary in 2013, and this milestone provides a
3 fitting opportunity to recognize its accomplishments; and

4 WHEREAS, Founded in Lubbock in 1988 by Carol Lee, the SPWRC is
5 a nonprofit organization that cares for all species of indigenous
6 wildlife with the goal of releasing these animals back into their
7 natural habitat; and

8 WHEREAS, The facility has grown to include full- and
9 part-time employees as well as several dozen dedicated volunteers,
10 junior volunteers, and Texas Tech University interns; assisted by
11 two local veterinary clinics, the SPWRC treats approximately 2,500
12 wildlife patients every year; the center also conducts a number of
13 educational outreach programs; and

14 WHEREAS, Over the past quarter-century, the vital endeavors
15 of the South Plains Wildlife Rehabilitation Center have helped
16 countless animals and enriched the lives of innumerable citizens,
17 and the organization has earned the profound appreciation of all
18 who treasure the natural ecosystem of the Lone Star State; now,
19 therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
21 Legislature hereby commemorate the 25th anniversary of the
22 establishment of the South Plains Wildlife Rehabilitation Center
23 and honor the staff and volunteers for their hard work and
24 dedication in its behalf; and, be it further
