R E S O L U T I O N

21 Dunn, Dr. Dunn has teamed with her to benefit the Irving cultural  
22 scene; the couple co-chaired the Irving Symphony League Ball, and  
23 both Dr. and Mrs. Dunn have been honored by the Irving Symphony  
24 Orchestra as members of the Amati Circle; in 2010, they were crowned

1 king and queen of the Irving Community Theater Guild's Mardi Gras  
2 celebration; the Dunns are members of the Lyric Stage League, and  
3 Mrs. Dunn is a fellow 2013 Irving High Spirited Citizen; and

4 WHEREAS, Jerry Dunn has demonstrated exceptional dedication  
5 to the betterment of his community, and his myriad contributions  
6 have garnered the lasting respect and appreciation of the residents  
7 of Irving; now, therefore, be it
