1 WHEREAS, John Schingle of the Irving Police Department
2 received the Community Builder Award from the James V. Callan
3 Da-Lite Masonic Lodge on February 9, 2013; and

4 WHEREAS, Created by the Grand Lodge of Texas in 1991, the
5 award recognizes non-Masons who have distinguished themselves
6 through exceptional service to others; and

9 history of helping young people and other area residents; he
10 enlisted the aid of the Irving Police Association to purchase
11 tickets to Six Flags for two siblings whose father was murdered, and

16 and traveled with the Irving Special Olympics team, holding a
17 second job to earn money to benefit the group; he coaches and raises
18 funds for the Irving Little League program, recruiting teams and
19 bringing them to North Texas for competitions, and he is working to
20 increase access to the program for Irving public schoolchildren;

22 WHEREAS, Officer Schingle also finds the time in his busy
23 schedule to volunteer with Make-A-Wish and to visit sick children
24 at the Scottish Rite Hospital; and

2 and resources with others are indeed deserving of our profound
3 admiration and gratitude, and John Schingle, who has enriched the
4 lives of countless individuals, sets an outstanding example of
5 community involvement to which all may aspire; now, therefore, be
