1 WHEREAS, Abigail Fonseca, a sophomore at Glen Rose High
2 School, has excelled in competition at the 2013 Visual Arts
3 Scholastic Event, where her superior rating earned her a state
4 medal for her work; and

5 WHEREAS, Sponsored by the Texas Art Education Association,
6 VASE is an annual contest that recognizes exemplary student
7 achievement in the visual arts in 10 categories that range from
8 painting, photography, and graphic design to sculpture, jewelry,
9 ceramics, and textiles; students from across the state first
10 compete at the regional level, where a panel of jurors evaluates
11 their pieces with regard to originality of concept, technical
12 expertise, and other criteria; only the top 10 percent of entries
13 advance to the state competition; and

14 WHEREAS, More than 15,000 art pieces were entered in the 2013
15 contest, and only 1,400 works advanced to the final level; of those,
16 fewer than half received a superior rating from state judges;
17 Abigail Fonseca secured such a score with her pencil drawing and was
18 honored with a state medallion in recognition of her achievement;

21 this gifted young Texan has demonstrated outstanding skill and
