6 where she earned a bachelor's degree in social studies education
7 and interior design, Ms. Bosarge is the founder, president, and
8 director of the nonprofit Music Doing Good, Inc., which is
9 dedicated to inspiring and transforming lives through music;
10 through its Music Doing Good in Schools project, the organization
11 provides high-quality after-school music education for Title I
12 schools in the Houston Independent School District; a companion
13 program, Music Doing Good with Instruments, provides gently used
14 musical instruments free of charge to underserved children and
15 underfunded school districts; and

16 WHEREAS, Ms. Bosarge is also a director of the Bosarge Family
17 Foundation, which supports a variety of charities related to the
18 arts, education, medical research, and social services;
19 beneficiaries include A Glimmer of Hope, the Boothbay Region YMCA,
20 and the Harlem Academy; in addition, she serves on the Women's
21 Initiative Advisory Council, the National Finance Committee for the
22 George W. Bush Foundation, and the Houston Symphony Board of
23 Trustees; and

24 WHEREAS, The wife of Dr. W. E. Bosarge, Ms. Bosarge shares

1 leadership with her husband in a number of family business
2 ventures; she is a director of Petrodome Energy, an oil and gas
3 exploration company that operates in Texas, Louisiana, and the Gulf
4 of Mexico, and the vice president of Capital Technologies; and

5 WHEREAS, This gracious Houstonian's generosity with her
6 time, energy, and creativity has greatly enhanced the lives of
7 countless individuals, and she may indeed reflect with pride on her
8 many contributions to her community and to the Lone Star State; now,
9 therefore, be it

11 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the philanthropic and charitable
12 endeavors of Marie Taylor Bosarge and extend to her sincere best
