16 to his community through his affiliation with the Rotary Club of
17 Seguin, and he played an active role in Toastmasters International;

20 of First United Methodist Church, where he held numerous committee
21 leadership positions, sang in the choir, and participated in the
22 Sharers Sunday School Class and the Methodist Men; and

24 support of his wife of nearly five decades, Dolores; the couple

1 became the proud parents of two children, Jeff and Karen, and
2 delighted in seeing their family grow to include nine

5 counted jogging, working in the yard, going to the beach, and
