3 on March 3, 2013, at the age of 18; and

4 WHEREAS, A graduate of Northbrook High School, Mr. Hernandez
5 was a dedicated student who excelled academically, placing in the
6 top 10 percent of his class; he was also a talented trumpet player
7 in the school band; and

8 WHEREAS, The first member of his family to attend college,
9 Mr. Hernandez was a freshman at Texas A&M University at the time of
10 his death; a general studies major, he participated in the Darling
11 Recruiting Company in the elite Corps of Cadets at Texas A&M, a
12 rigorous program that requires exceptional mental commitment and
13 physical training; and

15 brings immeasurable sorrow to his family and friends, Miguel
16 Hernandez leaves behind many treasured memories that may comfort
17 those who held him dear; now, therefore, be it
