RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Greco-Roman and freestyle wrestling were recently

2 dropped from the Summer Games as of 2020 in a stunning decision by

3 the International Olympic Committee; and

WHEREAS, One of the earliest and most elemental Olympic

5 sports, wrestling made its first appearance at the ancient Olympic

6 Games in 708 B.C. and has been part of modern Olympic competition

7 since 1896; the sport is well-established in the athletic culture

8 of the United States, which has won 124 Olympic medals over the

9 years; and

10 WHEREAS, The State of Texas is home to thousands of young

11 wrestlers, many of whom advance to national and international

12 competition; some 350 high school programs represent more than

13 10,000 athletes, and over 400 wrestling clubs engage more than

14 4,000 children from ages 6 to 14; in addition, numerous college

15 athletes compete for The University of Texas at Austin, Texas A&M

16 University, and other institutions; and

WHEREAS, From November to May each year, Texas hosts hundreds

18 of local and regional meets, including qualifiers to national

19 competition; these events have a positive impact on the state's

20 economy, and the prospect of participating athletes reaching the

21 Olympics contributes significantly to the vitality of these

22 tournaments; and

23 WHEREAS, The removal of wrestling from the Olympic Games will

24 have an adverse effect on the sport while diminishing the global

- 1 appeal of the games themselves and eroding an important link to
- 2 their earliest history; now, therefore, be it
- 3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
- 4 Legislature hereby express its opposition to the decision of the
- 5 International Olympic Committee to omit freestyle and Greco-Roman
- 6 wrestling from the Olympic Games beginning in 2020; and, be it
- 7 further
- 8 RESOLVED, That the chief clerk forward an official copy of
- 9 this resolution to the International Olympic Committee.
