- 15 volunteered his expertise across the nation during power
- 16 emergencies and led power restoration efforts in the Bellaire area
- 17 after Hurricane Ike; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Mr. Boone further distinguished himself as
- 19 president, treasurer, and section director of the Spring Shadows
- 20 Civic Association and as president of Super Neighborhood North;
- 21 moreover, he supported numerous charitable endeavors, including
- 22 the United Way and March of Dimes, and he participated in the BP MS
- 23 150 bike ride from Houston to Austin; and
- 24 WHEREAS, In his leisure time, Mr. Boone delighted in the
