4           WHEREAS, "Hank" Garza was born in Houston on January 12,  
5 1945; he graduated from Stephen F. Austin High School before  
6 embarking on a career with the Houston Fire Department that went on  
7 to span 35 years; his brave work in behalf of his fellow citizens  
8 earned him the respect of all who knew him; and

9           WHEREAS, Mr. Garza shared a rewarding marriage with his wife,  
10 Teresa, and he was the proud father of five children, Annette,  
11 Henry, Melissa, Elizabeth, and Lisa Ann; over the passing years, he  
12 took great pleasure in welcoming into his family six grandchildren;

14           WHEREAS, In his leisure time, Mr. Garza enjoyed playing golf,  
15 going on trail rides, camping, and cheering on the Houston Texans  
16 football team; he was actively involved with the National Pan  
17 American Golf Association, the Fort Bend County Vaqueros, the St.  
18 Frances Cabrini Catholic Church Men's Club, and the Knights of  
19 Columbus No. 3700, and he was a lifetime member of the Houston  
20 Livestock Show and Rodeo, which he served as a member of the  
21 directions and assistance committee; and

22           WHEREAS, While the death of Hank Garza brings great sadness  
23 to his loved ones, he leaves behind a legacy that will long be  
24 treasured by all those who held him dear; now, therefore, be it
