1 WHEREAS, Dedicated volunteers helped preserve the beauty of
2 Pilot Point on April 6, 2013, during the 8th Annual Trash-Off hosted
3 by Keep Pilot Point Beautiful; and

4 WHEREAS, More than 190 people turned out on a Saturday
5 morning to collect trash throughout the city; after several hours,
6 participants had amassed 222 bags of garbage and filled 57 trucks
7 with brush debris for a total of more than three large dumpsters'
8 worth of collected waste; the long morning of work was rewarded with
9 a hot meal provided by Midway Baptist Church; and

10 WHEREAS, Local businesses also assisted in the community
11 effort, with Integrity Car Care collecting 80 used tires, 10 car
12 batteries, and 40 gallons of motor oil, Axtell Pharmacy and
13 Compounding Center accepting unwanted prescription medication, and
14 Electronic Waste Disposal assisting in the removal of discarded
15 electronics; and

16 WHEREAS, Preserving the natural splendor of the Lone Star
17 State requires an active and responsible citizenry, and by taking
18 part in this worthwhile endeavor, these public-spirited
19 individuals have demonstrated an outstanding commitment to the area
20 they call home; now, therefore, be it
