1 WHEREAS, Longtime baseball coach and educator Hector Salinas 2 received well-deserved recognition when he was inducted into the Texas A&M University--Kingsville Javelina Athletic Hall of Fame in 3 February 2013; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Coach Salinas was instrumental in creating the Texas A&M--Kingsville baseball program, and he was named the team's first 6 7 head coach in 1993; his ball clubs had a winning record in each of the six seasons he was at the helm, and his teams claimed two Lone 8 9 Star Conference championships; the first came in 1995, the same year he was named LSC Coach of the Year, and his players won the 10 11 title again in 1998 and became the first Javelina team to go to the 12 NCAA Division II playoffs; skilled at developing young talent, he guided 25 first team All-Conference players, 6 LSC Players of the 13 14 Year, and 2 NCAA Division II All-Americans during his tenure at the 15 university; and WHEREAS, The success Coach Salinas enjoyed with the Javelinas 16 was built on his extensive baseball experience; a superb athlete in 17 his own right, he played for Corpus Christi High School and then 18 became an All-American at The University of Texas--Pan American; he 19 20 began his career in education in 1968 at Tom Browne Middle School in Corpus Christi and went on to teach classes and coach baseball at 21 Miller High School, Moody High School, Texas Southmost College, and 22
