R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Reverend Max A. Miller, Jr., of Mount Hebron  
2 Missionary Baptist Church in Houston served as Pastor of the Day for  
3 the Texas House of Representatives on April 12, 2013; and

4 WHEREAS, Since 2008, Reverend Miller has ably led Mount  
5 Hebron MBC, which was founded in 1958 by his uncle,  
6 Dr. J. J. Roberson; during his fine tenure, Reverend Miller has  
7 overseen numerous ministries and outreach efforts, including many  
8 options for young people and various activities at the church's

16 member of the Mayor's Ministerial Advisory Committee and has served  
17 as a ministerial liaison to the Houston public schools and as chair  
18 of the Southeast City Wide Street Ministry; moreover, he has  
19 distinguished himself as a member of Houston Ministers Against  
20 Crime, the NAACP, and the Bayou Oaks Civic Club, and he is the  
21 former president of the Garden Villas Elementary School Parent  
22 Teacher Association; and

23 WHEREAS, A graduate of Milby High School in Houston, Reverend  
24 Miller attended Prairie View A&M University and graduated from

1 Theodacious Theological Seminary in Houston; continuing his  
2 studies, he is currently pursuing a master's degree in business  
3 administration from the College of Biblical Studies; and

4 WHEREAS, Reverend Miller exemplifies the highest standards  
5 of his vocation, and he has benefited many Texans with his strong  
6 faith and leadership; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas  
8 Legislature hereby honor the Reverend Max A. Miller, Jr., for his  
9 service as Pastor of the Day and extend to him sincere best wishes  
10 for continued success and fulfillment; and, be it further
