12 and third in the physics and astronomy division; he took first in
13 science at the 2012 Texas Math and Science Coaches Association
14 state championship meet and competed in the 2013 American
15 Mathematics Contest, where he earned commendation for his high
16 score; and

18 top violin soloist in his category at a 2012 state music contest,
19 and he has had numerous poems and essays accepted for publication;
20 his accomplishments have qualified him for national-level

24 Sanjukta Ghose, Syamantak Payra has demonstrated impressive
